

Family Dispute Resolution





What does FDR involve?

FDR involves several steps designed to help you resolve parenting arrangements yourselves. Each family's path through FDR may be different, depending on a number of factors.

Who is eligible and does everyone need to go?

Any person who has a dispute with another person about the care of children may be eligible to attend FDR. Most people need to go to FDR before going to the Family Court.

The FairWay Resolution Coordinator will speak to you, give you information, and help assess whether your situation is suitable for FDR.

Who pays for the FDR service?

FDR Mediation is free if you qualify for government funding.

To find out whether you qualify for funding call us on **0800 77 44 20** and talk to one of our specialist Resolution Coordinators or go to the funding calculator at www.justice.govt.nz/family

If you do not qualify for funding, the fee is \$448.50 per person. Our Resolution Coordinators will explain the costs to you.
